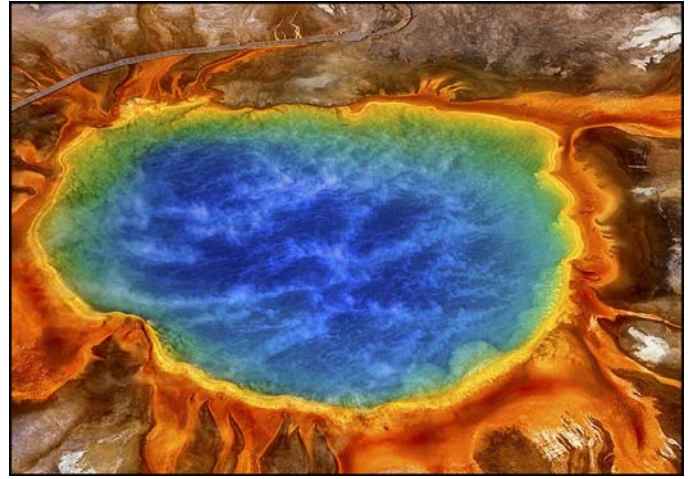

The Center for Fine Art Photography presents its newest exhibition, ***Elements of Water*** on display in the Center's gallery from February 19 – March 13, 2010. Forty-five photographers representing, Canada, India, Israel, and the United States will be exhibiting their work. The opening reception will be held on Friday March 5, from 6 – 9 PM.



Juror of ***Elements of Water*** is John Paul Caponigro, artist, author, educator and digital pioneer. John Paul's work has been published widely. He is considered one of the 15 best artists of the past 30 years and was recently inducted into the Photoshop Hall of Fame. Mr. Caponigro noted this about the exhibition, 'With such a rich and complex theme it's not surprising that the entries for this exhibit were so diverse. The images spanned the gamut of human responses to a single theme - documentary, graphic, impressionistic, clinical, avant-garde, romantic, personal... The results are a kaleidoscopic survey of possibilities.'

Founded in 2004 to promote the art of photography through exhibitions and education, the Center is a nonprofit organization supported by donations, grants and memberships. The Center for Fine Art Photography currently has more than 1,300 members representing 33 countries worldwide. Although its headquarters and gallery are in Fort Collins, Colorado, an on-line gallery gives photographers and photography enthusiasts from all over the globe an opportunity to
